RULES GOVERNING THE AWARD OF OVERSEAS MEDALS

1. The Society's Overseas Medals can be awarded to Shows affiliated to the Welsh Pony and Cob Society who have, prior to their show, paid the affiliation fee of £10.50. The fee of £45.00 includes the medal and the cost of a display case.
2. An Affiliated Show, to be eligible for the award of the Society's Overseas Medal, must have classification in their schedule providing at least four classes for any one Section of the Stud book for stallions, mares, geldings or youngstock registered in the appropriate overseas Stud Book or the Welsh Pony and Cob Society Stud Book.
3. The judge must be on at least one of the WPCS judging panels.
4. Copies of Show Schedules must be provided prior to going to final print for approval.
5. Overseas association rules will apply to all WPCS classes.
6. Show Secretaries, if they wish the medal results to be included in the Journal, must return the result certificates supplied to them on receipt, in the Society's Office, of the completed medal affiliation form and appropriate fee. These to be correctly signed by the officiating judge/s to confirm the Champion in the appropriate Sections/Championships where medals are awarded.

** It is not compulsory for the awards to be printed in the Journal, please indicate on the Result Card where appropriate but the Result Card/s **MUST** be returned to the Society within 21 days of the date of the Show whether the results are to be printed in the Journal or not.

Copy for the Journal must be submitted to the WPCS, by 30th September annually.
