The Welsh Pony and Cob Society Charter

- The Welsh Pony and Cob Society was founded in 1901. The Registered Office of the Society is and will be, situated in Wales.
- It is the original Society for the native Welsh breeds of equines.
- The Welsh breeds are defined as Welsh Mountain Ponies, Welsh Ponies, Welsh Ponies of Cob type, Welsh Cobs and all derivative part-bred equines from these four sub-sections of the Welsh breed.
- The Welsh Pony and Cob Society acts as the mother society for all WPCS societies, daughter societies and associations around the world
- Its aim is to promote, protect and maintain the breed standards as defined in the descriptions outlined in the Welsh Stud book.
- The Society aims to advance public education in all countries about the Welsh breeds.
- The WPCS promotes best welfare practice and aims to prevent cruelty to horses and ponies.
- The Society promotes and facilitates the acquisition and distribution of information about the Welsh Breeds in all parts of the world.
- Its aim is to continue the publication of the Welsh Stud Book, Welsh Part Bred Register, and Overseas Register

We, being a daughter Society or Association recognise the Welsh Pony and Cob Society as the founding and primary breed society for Welsh Ponies, Cobs and their Part-breds. We pledge allegiance in our affiliation and aim to uphold the Society's standards, values, and ideals to promote the Welsh breeds, the Stud book, and the Society.
