**HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW SEMI FINAL  
INHAND QUALIFIER**

**2022 SEWPCA – RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**  
**STRICT COVID 19 RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLY AT THIS HORSE SHOW**

1. Competitors must ensure that they hold adequate third party insurance cover in respect of any accident caused by themselves, their family or helpers, their vehicles or animals when on the showground.
2. **THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.**
3. The organisers, owners of the showground, or any of the committee, officers, servants or assistants shall not in any way be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen (for any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to exhibitors or their assistants or any member of the public, to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought on to the showground, or any premises used in conjunction with or arising out of or attainable to the show. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant or spectator shall indemnify the show organisers against such matters aforesaid.
4. Everyone in attendance at this event must abide by the instructions given by officials.
5. WPCS Rules /UKPH & NPS Rules will apply to applicable classes. Please ensure you are familiar with these rules before signing the entry form, including all Data Protection new rules.
6. All ridden ponies must be four years old and over and registered in their respective stud books, including Part Breds. Competitors are reminded that it is a legal requirement for passports to be carried when transporting ponies. Riders of Small Stallions must have attained their 12th birthday and Riders of Large Stallions must have attained their 14th Birthday.
7. All objections must be lodged with the Secretary within 30 minutes of the disputed event and confirmed in writing, with a deposit of £50. This will be returned should the objection be upheld. **Please note:** No Judge may be approached directly regarding an objection.
8. No clearing out of Horse Boxes/ Trailers, etc. is allowed on the showground, this includes any litter.
9. In the event that the show has to be cancelled, refunds of entries will be given. These refunds will be issued minus an admin fee.
10. Refunds will only be issued if a valid doctor's or veterinary certificate is submitted. All refunds are subject to review by the SEWPCA committee.
11. Anyone displaying aggressive, rude or threatening behaviour towards judges, show officials or other competitors will be immediately ejected from the showground, banned from future SEWPCA shows and if a SEWPCA member, their membership will be cancelled forthwith with no right of appeal and without refund of any entries or subscriptions.
12. The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without giving reason, to change judges or to amalgamate/split classes if entries warrant.
13. All entries must be fully registered in their section of the Welsh Stud Book, or their respective breed societies, with the exception of Foals, which must however be eligible for registration. All foals must be at least 3 weeks old.
14. All ponies and cobs must comply with the WPCS height limits.
15. All colts and stallions must comply with the WPCS rules. This includes ridden stallions.
16. An exhibitor may not enter a pony in any class which is to be judged by a person who has bred, sold, leased, produced or has had any financial gain from that animal.
17. All exhibits will enter and leave the ring at a walk.
18. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground and be to current hat standards. No top hats allowed, and suitable footwear must be worn.
19. We advise you to wear body protectors.
20. Under 14 year olds must wear hard hats when showing ponies inhand.
21. No whips or canes to exceed 75cms (30 inches).
22. No plaiting in any m & m breed class (except for small plait behind the ear), with the exception of the Welsh Part-Bred ponies where plaiting is optional. **WHISKERS RULING INFORCE.**
23. **PLEASE NOTE: Trophies will only be awarded to competitors who are paid up members of SEWPCA.**
24. All dogs must be kept on leads.
25. No ponies or cobs are allowed to be tied to the side of vehicles.
26. If you are asked by a committee member or SEWPCA staff to move your vehicle for any reason, please do so as failure to do this will result in it being towed off the showground.

**NPS Qualifying Rounds, Breed Show Rules:** These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern in **August 2022. T.**

**NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships, Breed Show Rules:** These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. At breed shows Silver Medals may be won by non-members. The owner of the qualified pony must become an Adult Qualifying or Life member to enter the final. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third).

The Supreme In-Hand Qualifier held at Stoneleigh Horse Show is a qualifier for the Horse of The Year Show, NEC, 5th-9th October, 2022. The Objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in the Qualifier for the Supreme In-Hand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In-Hand Semi Final qualifier in 2022.

Champions from the 4 Welsh Section A, B, C, D, & Welsh Part Bred, M & M inhand Silver medal champion, Part Bred champion, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony are all eligible to take part (sadly no geldings over four years old or foals are allowed) in this championship.

If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2022 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to Stoneleigh, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2022 or are ineligible then the Semi-Final will not be represented at

Stoneleigh. Foal champions and geldings four years old and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for Horse of the Year Show.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the Semi Final qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2nd and any subsequent sections.

All classes are open to Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Stallions, broodmares and barren mares only. Broodmares must be with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy.

Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year.

There will be no direct entry into the Supreme In-Hand Championship Semi Final, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable).

Day membership must be purchased from VHS head office at least 2 weeks in advance of the show, at a cost of **£20**. Payment by telephone and a Credit or Debit card is required. A day membership show card and age badge will be provided. Owners who are not competing are not required to be a member.

All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

Members and Day members must carry their current VHS membership card **in the ring** and produce these on request – no exceptions will be made. No card no entry or qualification.

**VHS Supreme Final qualification.** Competitors placed 1st and 2nd in each class will also qualify directly for the corresponding class at the VHS Supreme Final, to be held at the National Veteran Championships. (V.O.Y.S.) 1st - 3rd October 2021, Arena UK, Lincolnshire.

**VHS Regional Final qualification.** All competitors placed 3rd - 4th in each class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals.

**VHS M&M Supreme Final qualification.** This is only given at the judges discretion and will be to the highest placed M&M in each class to qualify for the VHS M&M Supreme Final at the National Veteran Championships. Show Card to be signed.

Members and Day-members will have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Day-members must become full VHS members within 14 days and exchange their day- showing card for a full showing card in order to validate their qualification for the Supreme or Regional Final qualification. Regional Finals are open to members only.

If the competitor has already qualified or does not wish to attend, they must refuse the qualification and pass it down the line **on the day**. Day members must become full VHS members in order to enter the Supreme Final.

Once you have a Supreme Qualification you must enter the Supreme Final within 21 days of gaining this qualification - NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, 30<sup>th</sup> September – 2<sup>nd</sup> October, Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.
