### Application Form for WPCS Funding 2023

The Welsh Pony and Cob Society welcome applications for funding from organisations and groups whose aims align with the Society's aims and objectives. Each application will be assessed on its own merits but inevitably there are limits to the amount of funds that are available.

The Society's primary objectives are:

- *To encourage the breeding and improvement of horses and ponies more especially those of the Welsh Breeds.*
- *To advance the breeding in all districts and countered in the various arts and sciences connected with the use and management of horses and ponies in general and of the Welsh mountain Pony, the Welsh Pony, the Welsh Pony (Cob Type) and the Welsh Cob (hereinafter referred to as "the Welsh Breeds") and their Part-Breeds.*
- *To provide or assist in the provision for the public benefit, of facilities for recreation or other leisure time occupation, through the use of horses and ponies, but confined to facilities provided in the interests of social welfare within the meaning and so as to satisfy the requirements of the Recreational Charities Act 1958.*
- *To prevent cruelty to and promote the welfare of horses and ponies.*

The Society welcomes applications for funding from organisations or groups that have similar aims to those of the Society, with all applications assessed on an annual basis. If you would like to apply for funding from the Society, please complete this form and return with supporting documentation to the **Finance Officer, Welsh Pony and Cob Society, Bronaeron, Felinfach, Lampeter, Ceredigion, SA48 8AG**, to arrive no later than **5pm on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> of November 2022**. (this closing date will be strictly adhered to)

Any applications recommended for funding by the Society's Finance and HR committee will need to be ratified by Council; therefore it may take up to 3 months from the closing date for applications before you hear whether your application is successful or not.

It is important to include all supporting documentation and information at the point of submission of your application and that the application form is completed in black ink. **A copy of the group/organisations accounts for the previous year will be required.** The Society reserves the right to request additional information or to invite the applicant for interview before a final decision is made.

If funding is awarded, you will be required to submit a report to the Society on how the funds have been applied, with supporting documentation, within a 12 month period of award.

If for any reason the intended use of the funds is cancelled or withdrawn, the Society must be notified and the funds returned in full. Any deviations to the original purpose of the funding must be agreed with the Society prior to alternative uses of funds being made.

Applicants need to demonstrate how the intended use of the funds match the primary aims of the Society and what benefit will be gained as a result.
