Types of Membership

Annual Membership runs from 1 January to 31 December and costs **£43.00** (UK pounds sterling) or £38.00 if paying by Direct Debit.

Junior Membership for individuals aged 18 and below runs from 1 January to 31st December and costs £13.00 (UK pounds sterling)

Currency

Our subscriptions are shown in UK pounds sterling (£).

You may pay by Access, Visa, Mastercard, Eurocard, and Switch. We recommend you use a credit card if you live outside the UK: your card or account will be debited the equivalent amount in your own currency.

Direct Debit

For those with a British bank account, the best way to pay for your membership is via direct debit using a variable amount direct debit mandate. This is strongly recommended, since it means that your annual subscription is collected every January, without any further effort from yourself. If the mandate is set up part way through the year, please allow 3-6 weeks before collection is taken for the current year as collections are made in the first week of each month.

Direct Debit applications must be sent in on the original form. Photocopies or scans are not acceptable.

If you live in a multi journal household—where several members reside and you do not feel that you must receive a journal this will save the Society funds spent on printing and postage of unnecessary volumes of the Annual Journal. If you would like to opt-out of receiving a Journal please tick this box.
